

Sample Processing Notes

- 1) Please allow 2-4 weeks for normal processing of samples. This does not allow for any shipping delays of incoming samples or outgoing results. If you need a shorter processing time due to an inspection or audit, please ship using tracking services with the carrier of your choice. Then notify us in *advance* of sending in samples by emailing us at lab@NationalLeakTest.com. Without advance notice, it is difficult to track your order due to the volume of samples we have in the lab at any one time. You may also request emailing of the results when sending in your samples.
- 2) We are ***not*** responsible for inaccuracies and delays due to incomplete, illegible or missing paperwork. Please take the time to read the instructions enclosed in the kit(s) and follow these instructions. Please mark ***ALL*** correspondence and samples with your **CUSTOMER NUMBER**. Also having an email address provided can make the process more efficient in case we have any questions.
- 3) Special labeling is ***not*** required for *any* carrier. Do ***not*** mark the package radioactive. It is ***not*** radioactive even if it is contaminated.
- 4) If you are sending multiple kits for processing, please place them all in a single shipping package so they do not get separated in shipping.
